## COVID-19 Protocols

### For All Players, Team Managers/Administrators, and Referees

1. Every Columbus Premier Soccer League participant (players, managers, coaches, team administrators, referees) must complete a COVID-19 Self-Assessment before heading to the playing venue each day. If you answer YES to ANY of the items on the assessment, you are not allowed to participate, should stay home and are encouraged to contact your healthcare professional for advice on whether you should be tested for COVID-19.
2. You will also be required to complete the COVID-19 Self-Assessment when you arrive at the playing facility, and you will be required to initial your understanding and acceptance of its contents next to your name on the Official Match Roster prior to participating. If you fail to do so, you will not be allowed to participate. If you participate without completing the COVID-19 Self-Assessment, you will be removed from the playing field and may result in your team's forfeiture of the game and/or your suspension from subsequent match(es).
3. Immediately upon arriving at the playing facility – before you do anything else (warming up, etc.) – you must have your temperature taken by your team manager or administrator. If you arrive late and your manager is unavailable to take your temperature (for example, because he is on the field playing), you must go to the CPSL tent/table to have your temperature taken there BEFORE you are allowed to participate. If you fail to have your temperature taken either by your team's manager or by a league representative (not referee), you will be removed from the playing field and may result in your team's forfeiture of the game and/or your suspension from subsequent match(es)

If your temperature is above 100.4°F (38°C), you are not allowed to participate and must immediately leave the facility for the day; and you are encouraged to contact your healthcare professional for advice on whether you should be tested for COVID-19.
